1 box yellow cake mix
Chocolate chips (semisweet)
Graham crackers- crushed
Jar of Fluff



Make cake according to box directions. Add 1 1/2 cups crushed graham crackers to mix, then stir in about 1 cup of chips (may use more to taste)
Line cupcake pans with paper liners. Fill each 3/4 full with batter and then top with crushed grahams. Bake about 10 minutes or until golden. Once out of the oven , top each cupcake with fluff.....then enjoy!!!!

"Fried" Ice Cream

6" soft Tortillas
4-6 cups Rice Crispy cereal- crushed fine
1/2 cup cinnamon
4 cups sugar
Vanilla ice cream
Vegetable oil for frying
2 Zip Lock bags



Mix cinnamon and sugar together. Put about 2 1/2 cups aside in large bowl. In one Zip Lock bag, add finely crushed Crispies and about 1 1/2 cups cinnamon/sugar mixture. Scoop ice cream into hard balls and place in other bag. Press the crispy mixture into the ice cream. Place in freezer until ready. Heat vegetable oil and fry the tortillas until golden on both sides. Immediately cover with cinnamon/sugar mixture on both sides. Place ice cream on top of tortilla. Serve with whipped cream and drizzle chocolate syrup if desired. This is best served when the tortilla is hot, so you can place them in the oven on warm, until ready to serve.
